INPEX-operated Ichthys LNG Project Commences LPG Shipment

TOKYO, JAPAN - [INPEX CORPORATION](#) (INPEX) announced today that the INPEX-operated Ichthys LNG Project (the Project) has commenced shipment of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) from the onshore gas liquefaction plant in Darwin in the Northern Territory of Australia.

The first shipment of LPG is destined to an Asian buyer. INPEX is poised to continue responding to the energy demand in Japan, Asia and the rest of the world. The Project has already commenced shipment of condensate (ultra-light crude oil), as [announced on October 1, 2018](#), and of liquefied natural gas (LNG), as [announced on October 23, 2018](#).
